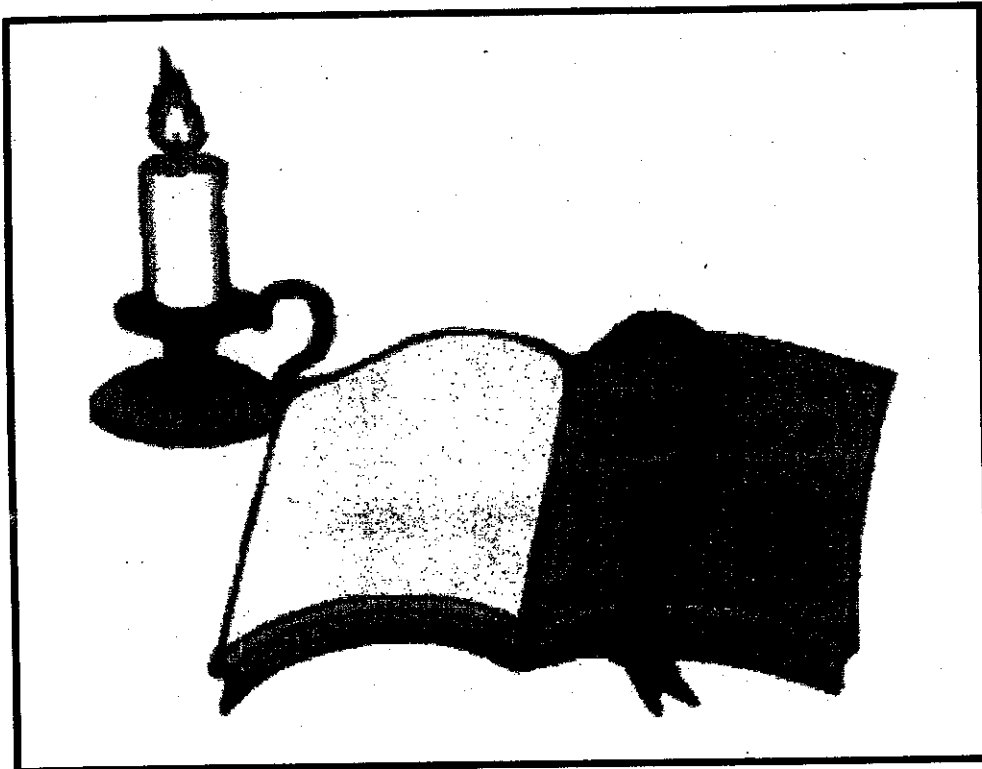

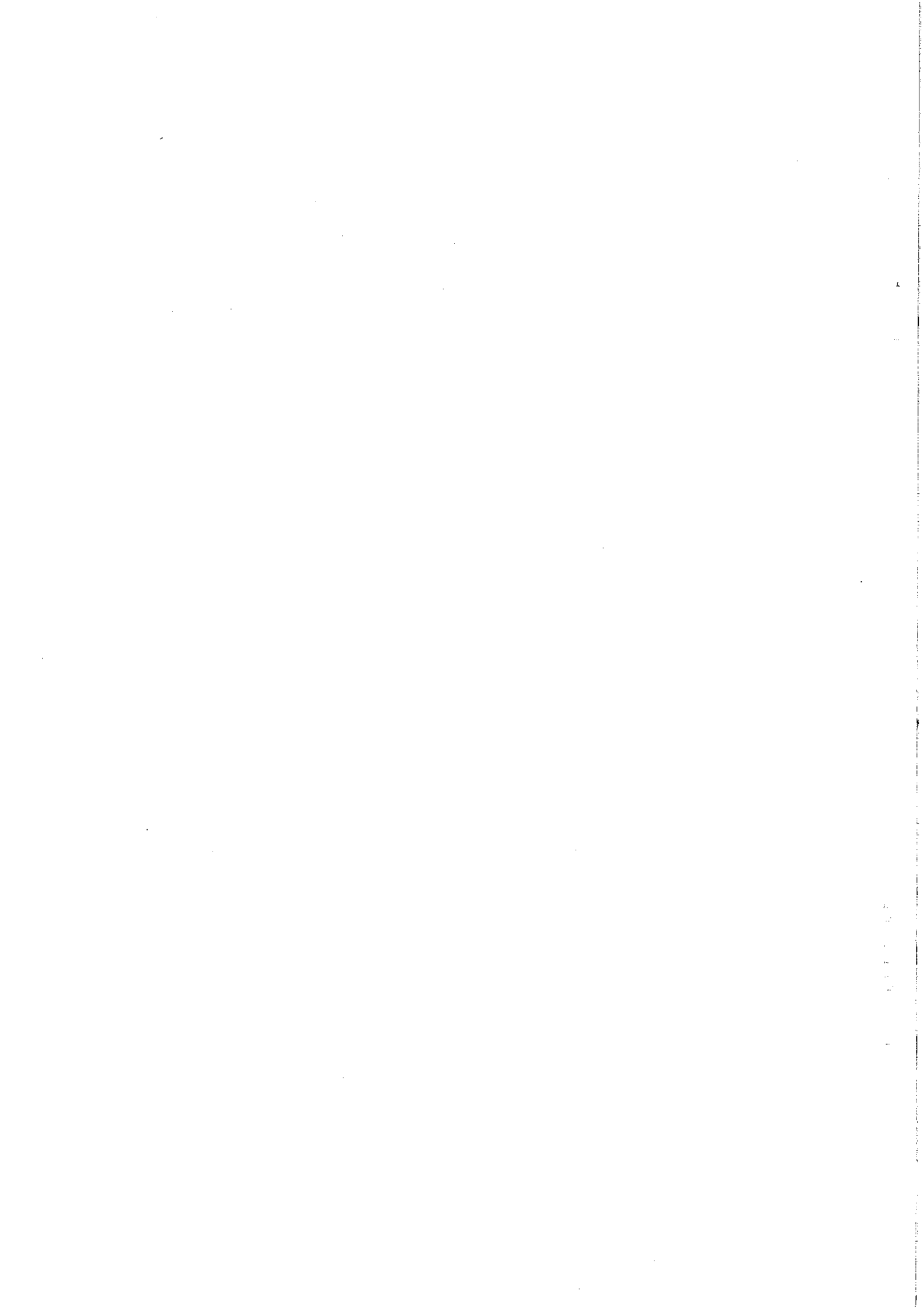

- In many Circumstances, the Christian is called to make promises to God. Baptism Confirmation, Matrimony and Holy Orders always entail promises. Out of personal devotion, the Christian may also promises to God to do certain things. eg: to say extra prayers, to give alms, to go on pilgrimages and so forth. Fidelity to the promises, made to God, is a sign of the respect, owed to the divine majesty, and of love for a faithful God.

(ii) Season of Lent

Lenten Season begins on Ash Wednesday and goes up to Holy Thursday

- This season remind us of the forty days and forty nights that Jesus spent in the wilderness praying and fasting before he began his public ministry.
- It is a time of prayer, fasting and alms giving.
- It is a time of reflecting and meditating on the paschal mystery, passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- It is a time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, die to sin and rise to new life with Christ.

During the season of Lent, Holy Mother Church invites the all Catholics to make the way of the cross, to participate in penitential services, to help the poor, to forgive others and to be forgiven. It is also the time for preparation for adult Baptism. Alleluia and Gloria are not sung during the season of Lent
